

## **Divination Responses for the Tomb**

**Consecration Aura:** *"You feel a profound sense of fulfillment from all your hard work has achieved. You feel no reward is beyond your reach if you strive for it"*

**Insight:** Will confirm that the Aura is true. There are no spiritual presences such as ghosts or spectres here

### **The lace wrapped items:**

The players will be pre-briefed of the fact that all the lace wrapped items look the same as items with ribbons on them. They will also be briefed that they all have the particular magical look that they all have a skein of years

Divination or Discern Enchantment on the items shows that is the ONLY things about them that makes them look magical

If they decide to cast Skein on them, I will give them the result on the spot.

## **For the Tomb itself**

### **Divination:**

All of the following will yield more information about the Tomb itself

Wisdom of the Balanced Blade

Insight

Discern Enchantment (though the information will be better and more detailed from WoBB)

Skein of Years

### **Wisdom of the Balanced Blade:**

This tomb has an Autumn magic effect Magnitude 20 on it.

The effect is a protection placed by the Autumn Eternal Callidus.

If any of the items from the tomb inventory are removed from the Tomb then the thieves are cursed with a Curse known as My Twisted Luck. Its effects are similar to Like Water through Fingers, although the bad luck experienced can be more general than just financial.

The disturbance to the Tomb appears to be due to the Curse having been triggered. If all missing items are returned to the Tomb the disturbance will quiet, and those suffering from My Twisted Luck will be freed.

Alternatively, the Autumn Eternal Callidus might be bargained with to find another solution.

**Discern Enchantment** Autumn Magic Effect Mag 20 (Bright Lantern of Ophis gives the same result, plus the name of Callidus– and a reminder that WoBB might tell more, if they choose to use it instead)

### **Skein of Years for the Tomb**

In the reign of Aenea the Builder the tomb is built and filled with people. Several Sutannir wrap the items with lace and coins in them, then perform a true liao enhanced consecration ceremony. Among those gathered is a Silver cambion horned Herald from the Autumn Realm – they are the last to leave.

In the reign of Emperor Barabbas, during a gathering of the faithful, one citizen, in a bright tagelmust and coat slips towards the table of objects and crosses behind the others to the exit. As she does so, she looks back as she feels the floor of the tomb shake. The clothing laid out in the tomb is sitting up. The dolls are moving. She drops the silvered peacock vase on the floor and runs.
