- Respected by all Jotun

- 3 hits
- Any armour
- Shield
- Chirurgeon
- Physick

Things to know:

Eirval are skilled healers, using surgery, herblore and magical potions to return Jotun to the fight. Their work commands respect.

They might have:

Healing herbs, healing potions, magical tools

Jotun Smidr



Battlefield smith

- Orc, or human thrall, serving the Kirkja
- Competent crafter
- Oversee item bondings
- Repair shattered items

Artisan

- 3 hits
- Any armour
- Artisan

Things to know:

The Jotun armies march to war well armed and equipped. Smidr are honoured for their expertise, be it in mundane or magical forging.

They might have:

Materials, Artisan's Oil, magical tools

Jotun Galdr



Battlefield mage

- Orc, or human thrall, serving the Kirkja
- Competent spellcaster
- Supports the artisans and healers
- Uncommon among Jotun

Artisan

- 2 hits
- Mage, Battle Mage
- Mend + Purify
 - Or
- Heal + Restore Limb

Things to know:

The Jotun make little use of mages in war, but they do support warriors can be found in larger warbands. Galdr are acknowledged for their skill, but not praised for it.

They might have:

Mageblood, Crystalised Mana

Jotun Thrall



Battlefield servants

- Thralls serving the Jotun
- Loyal to the Jotun
- Carry out orders
- Attend to a notable hero

Thrall

- 2 hits
- No armour
- No weapons

Things to know:

Thralls of the Jotun have made a choice not to fight, but they serve the armies in many other ways; cooks, servants, messengers, banner bearers, medical orderlies and much more.
