Night Magnitude 17

Performing the Ritual

Performing this ritual takes at least 2 minutes of roleplaying. This ritual targets a character, who must be present throughout. The target character must have the Hero points skill. The ritual must be performed under the night sky.

The ritual *must* include a musical performance, the more passionate the better.

This spell is an enchantment; a character may be under only one enchantment at a time.

Effects

This ritual draws on the power of Janon to grant the target both a hero point and a rank of Fortitude.

While under this enchantment, the target experiences a powerful roleplaying effect: whenever they experience an emotion, they experience it much more passionately than normal. They are much more likely to react badly to anything they see as restraining their behaviour, whether it is a law, an expectation of society, or a sign that says 'quiet please' on it.

While under this effect the target *must* respond to any roleplaying effect that attempts to dampen their expression of emotions, or to create feelings of calm, clarity or tranquillity, with an exuberant, passionate burst of emotion such as anger, happiness or enthusiasm.

The effect lasts until the start of the next Profound Decisions Empire event.

Additional Magnitude

This ritual can affect additional characters. The magnitude increases by ten for every additional target. All targets must be present throughout.

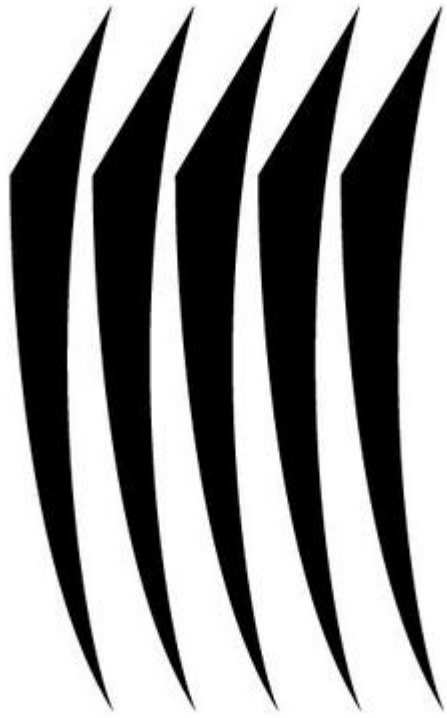
OOO note

This item is a ritual text.

Any character with the Night Ritual Lore skill can master this ritual. You must have a free slot or experience point to master a new ritual. After an appropriate period of roleplaying spent studying these pages, it should then be brought to a referee who will add the ritual to those you have mastered. Doing this does not 'use up' the ritual text.

This ritual cannot be learned by other means; it cannot be taught by a character who knows it unless the ritual is added to the body of Imperial Lore by the Conclave.
