Music and lyrics by the Volchitrava Stzena

This song was commissioned in Winter 379 to commemorate the assigning of the territory of Skarsind to the Imperial Orcs. The song combines a traditional melody from Skarsind with the rhythmic chanting found in Imperial Orc music. The lyrics celebrate the outstanding Loyalty shown by both the people of Wintermark and the Imperial Orcs, whilst not demeaning the sacrifices made by both as the Orcs earned their new homeland.
